06/05/2018 – OSHA Proposed Limited-Compliance Extension for Beryllium Standard

The Occupational Safety and Health Administration and Dept. of Labor are proposing a nine-month extension of the compliance date (March 12, 2018 moved back to Dec. 12, 2018) for its general industry beryllium standard. The original rulemaking was reported on in a CIRT story dated (05/09/2018). OSHA has preliminarily determined that this proposal will maintain essential safety and health protections for workers while OSHA prepares an NPRM to clarify specific provisions of the beryllium standard that would both maintain the standard's worker safety and health protections and address employers' compliance burdens.
