09/25/2017 – CIRT Offers “Waters of U.S.” Comment

With the new Administration reopening the court “stayed” Obama-era rulemaking, CIRT submitted to the EPA and the Army Corps of Engineers its comment on their proposal to rescind the definition of “waters of the US” (WOTUS) established in a June 2015 final rule. CIRT supported the new proposal to re-codify the regulatory text with what existed prior to the 2015 WOTUS rule; saying in part: *“the design/construction community favors clear, concise, and balanced rules that achieve a specific well defined and scientific justified purpose consistent with the legislative language, court interpretations as well as the dictates of federalism and individual liberties.”* [See, [CIRT story on the matter dated 08/02/2017](#)].
