Hotel & Conference Information

Registration - The CIRT Fall Conference is open to members of record and invited guests. No vendors or consultants may attend unless otherwise invited as part of the program. There are no registration fees for CIRT members-of-record to attend, but members are responsible for their travel and hotel expenses. Likewise, spouses (other than extra "optional" events); all potential members; and/or successors that are invited to attend as a guest also will not be charged. However, a registration fee of \$550.00 (based on cost) will be charged for additional people attending from the same company beyond those described. The CIRT conferences are intended exclusively for members and invited guests.

This is our largest block of rooms but there are other room types available as follows:

Denver International Airport: Serviced by all major airlines; 75-minute drive; Shuttle service is available through Gray Line for \$95 per person one way; \$190 per person roundtrip. Advance reservations are required and can be made by calling (719) 362-3276. Average cab fare is \$240+.
