The April issue of *Public Works Financing* provides an in-depth look at PIRC's new investment tools. The issue is timed to be part of the larger discussion in mid-May during "**Infrastructure Week**," when thousands of advocates will convene in Washington, DC, and nationwide to present the case for increasing investment in public works. The Performance Infrastructure Review Committee (PIRC) is a bipartisan committee of individuals with expertise in federal policy, infrastructure development, and project finance. Over the past six months, PIRC has reviewed numerous concepts pertaining to how infrastructure is financed. The objective has been to develop a shortlist of those options that seem to have the greatest promise in terms of political practicality, budget affordability, and investment.
